Site Planning

Obtain an accurate plan of site
Carry out a grave site survey
Smaller areas help in identification
Include unmarked plots where known



Software Development

Choose Software - proprietary vs. generic

Alternatives may have graphics issues Handling of dates before 1900

How much data to include?

Suggested minimum: grave records, photos, biodata



Photography

Photograph each grave in good sunlight

Take shots from two or three angles

Include correlation shots to check locations

Brush powder on faded or worn inscriptions









Site Diagram


